## Visit to See the Snow Geese at Reifel Bird Sanctuary

The George C. Reifel Migratory Bird Sanctuary, located in Delta, is one of 92 federal Migratory Bird Sanctuaries in Canada. The Snow Geese, also known as the “Fraser-Skagit” flock, are part of a nesting population from Wrangel Island, Russia. While visiting they move between the estuaries of the Fraser and Skagit Rivers. The snow geese provide spectacular wildlife viewing, along with the other many varieties of birds at the Bird Sanctuary!
